## VIII. Committee on the Environment, Climate and Food Safety

Committee responsible for:

- 1. environmental and climate policy and protection measures, in particular concerning:
- (a) climate change, adaptation, resilience and preparedness,
- (b) environmental policy for the protection of public health,
- (c) air, soil and water pollution, waste management and recycling, <del>dangerous substances and preparations</del> noise levels and the protection of biodiversity,
- (d) chemicals, dangerous substances and preparations, pesticides <u>and maximum residue levels</u>, cosmetics,
- (e) sustainable development,
- (f) international and regional measures and agreements aimed at protecting the environment,
- (g) restoration of environmental damage,
- (h) civil protection,
- (i) the European Environment Agency,
- (j) the European Chemicals Agency;
- 2. food safety issues, including in particular:
- (a) the labelling and safety of foodstuffs,
- (b) veterinary legislation concerning protection against risks to human health; public health checks on foodstuffs and food production systems,
- (c) the European Food Safety Authority and the European Food and Veterinary Office.

Committee responsible for public health matters related to:

- (a) pharmaceuticals and medical devices
- (b) programmes and specific actions in the field of public health,
- (c) health crisis preparedness and response
- (d) mental health and patients right
- (e) health aspects of bioterrorism,
- (f) the European Medicines Agency and the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control;
- (g) relations with the WHO with the above topics
